Small Appliance Buyer's Checklist

Core Questions

Noise: acceptable for your space/time? Check dB ratings.

Footprint: fits your counter? Measure depth with plug.

Capacity: cook for how many? Don't oversize small kitchens.

Cleanability: dishwasher-safe parts? Nonstick quality?

Warranty/support: at least 1-year; easy parts availability.

Categories & Picks (structure placeholders)

Blender: Quiet pick (primary); budget pick (backup)

Air fryer: Compact 4–6 qt (primary); larger family size (backup)

Induction plate: 1-burner with stable temp; backup budget

Mixer: Hand mixer primary; stand mixer optional if bake-heavy

Fit/Skip Notes

Fit: renters/owners, small to mid kitchens, low-noise priority.

Skip: bulky multi-tools you won't use 2–3x/month.

Testing Routine

Run water test (blender/leaks), temp test (induction), evenness (air fryer toast), noise check at night.
